### **Sailing Instructions: Post Mid-Winter #1 Jack and Jill Around Treasure Island February 16, 2008**

**There will be no Skipper's Meeting for this race. The starting sequence will begin at noon.**

**Rules:** From starting line and around Treasure Island....Either Way... This race is open to yachts that must carry one male and one female crew and normally be crewed by more than two persons. The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing published by the United States Sailing Association. Changes or additions to these instructions will be posted on the BBYC bulletin board before 10 am on race day, or announced from the committee boat by VHF channel 69 or amplified voice hail. Changes may also be announced in the Racing section of [www.bbyc.org](http://www.bbyc.org). The course may be shortened at the discretion of the RC as wind conditions determine. Please monitor VHF channel 69 for changes.

**Handicap:** Northern California PHRF ratings will be used for time-on-distance handicapping. Boats with no Certificate of rating, or no sistership ratings (available at [www.yra.org](http://www.yra.org)) may participate but will not be scored.

**Class Divisions:** All boats will start together, with classification to be determined by number of participants.

**Start/Finish Line:** Between Orange flag on land near the Ballena Bay "Flagpole Circle" RC Race Deck area, and "L". Racing boats will leave "L" to Port at Start, and shall leave "L" to Starboard at Finish.

#### **Description of Marks:**

"L" BBYC spherical buoy near Ballena Isle Marina harbor entrance

"Treasure Island" Treasure Island

#### **Signals**

1200 Warning Class Flag "A" Raised Short Sound

1201 Preparatory Preparatory Flag "P" Raised Short Sound

1204 1-Minute Warning “P” Flag Lowered Long Sound  
1205 Start “A” Flag Lowered Short Sound

**Course**

Start (“L” to Port), Round Treasure Island either direction, Finish (“L” to Starboard)

**Distance: 15.6 nm**

**Time Limit** of 6 hours after Start will be in effect, after which no boats will be finished or scored.

**Check in:** By coming within hail of RC and identifying boat name and sail number, or by hailing RC on Ch 69 with same. In either case await confirmation from RC

**Check out:** Automatic upon receiving finishing gun or horn from RC boat. If abandoning Race before finish, or still on race Course after expiration of time limit, competitors are to check out with RC on Channel 69.

**Entry:** Will be made by completing, signing and returning with cash or check the BBYC 2008 Race Entry Form available at <http://www.bbyc.org/pages/Race/2008/BBYC2008RACEENTRYFORM.pdf> or in hard copy at the BBYC clubhouse.
